The appropriate sanction from the West Bengal Nursing Council has been obtained.

OBJECTIVES

The specion objectives of the Nurse-Midwifery track are to prepare nurses who will provide competent, safe, high-quality and culturally sensitive nursing care to address the health needs of all.

1. Name of the course with duration.

The Maheshtala Municipal Institute of Nursing Science will impart 3 year course on General Nursing and Midwifery.

- 2. Commencement of the course November , 2020
- 3. Eligibility criteria for admission
- Only female candidates are eligible.
- Age should not be less than 17 years and not more than 27 years on 31/12/2020.
- Candidates should be Indian Citizen and shall be residing in West Bengal uninterruptedly for the last 5(\(\omega\) years.
- Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination conducted by recognized council in any discipline having minimum 40% in aggregate and having 40% in English Language.
- Sale of prospectus from the Hospital Complex with application form 28/09/2020 to 10/10/2020 upto 4 P. M.
- Last date of submission of application form with all required copies of documents on 12/10/2020 upto 5 P.M. at hospital campus.
- Students will be selected through an admission test. Admission test will be held on 18/10/2020 at 1 P.M. at Kasturi Das Super Speciality Hospital Complex
- Publication of result: 20/10/2020
- ◆ Admit Cards to the eligible candidates will be delivered at the time of submission of completed application form at Kasturi Das Super Speciality Hospital Complex.
 All original certi⊠cates are to be produced at the time of admission.
- Incomplete or inaccurate application forms shall be liable to be rejected.
- Application forms with self attested copies of all testimonials and two recent passport size coloured photographs duly signed shall have to be submitted.
- NB. Application forms annexed with the prospectus shall be submitted in original. No photocopy will be allowed.
- Admission test will be conducted based on General Knowledge and Current Affairs, English Composition and Mathematics of class X standard, followed by viva voice.
- Merit list will be displayed on the InstitutionNotice Board at Hospital Complex.
- The selected candidates shall have to appear for medical check up against payment of fees of Rs 200/-
- ♦ The admission procedure will close by 28/10/2020 upto 4 P.M.
- No TA/D A will be admissible for attending for admission testand viva voice.

General Guideline in respect of the course.

- The Institution shall follow the general guidelines & rules and bye-laws as prescribed by the West Bengal Nursing Council and the Indian National Council from time to time.
- The Institution may prescribe Rules/Regulations/Bye -laws within the framework of guidelines of WBNC & INC for day to day administration and operation of the Maheshtala Municipal Instituteof Nursing Sciences
- The selected candidates shall have to stay in the hostel of the Institution and should arrange their uniform, bedding etc. Expenses for statutory training at Hospitals, Urban Primary Health Centers, Rural Primary Health Centre shall be borne by the students.
- Contingency charges should be paid by the students
- Lodging and normal meals will be provided to the students during the course
- During the academic period necessary treatments in case of illness will be provided but bed charges, cost of blood/medicines/pathological investigation etc are to be borne by the students.
- Vacation and holidays shall be allowed as per the guidelines of WBNC & INC.
- Students will be allowed for Council's Examination, if no dues are lying for Fees structure.
- ◆ Total fees (all inclusive) for the entire course for three years is Rs. 6.75 lakh (Six lakh seventy
 Nove thousand).
- First year Rs. 2,75,000/-

(Caution money amounting Rs. 25000/- shall be returned after completion of the course as per usual guideline)

- Second year Rs. 200000/-
- Third year Rs. 200000/-

NB: On year to year basis charges are to be paid in advance before starting of the each academic year.

No yearly charges shall be refunded in case any studentleaves the Institution midway.
